For thirty days the students used ReadySet as a daily supplement to their regular math class. David compared the results with another class of his that did not use ReadySet. The average scores for the students using ReadySet raised an average of 10.14% where the scores from the group of students that did not use ReadySet did not raise at all.

Williston Middle School in Williston, North Dakota decided to establish an after school program, called Period 8 that focused on enhancing the skills of students who were not proficient on last year's state tests.

*When we got our ND State test results back the increase was more than we expected. Our Student proficiency in Reading for 7th grade increased from 76% to 89% and our 8th graders from 69% to 82% and in math 7th grade increased from 79% to 87% and our 8th graders from 59% to 72%! We were ecstatic. The only variable from the year before was the identification of student needs through assessment and Period 8. I know Period 8 was only possible because of Qwizdom.
